Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Welcome to Term 3, I hope that you and your family have kept well during the school holiday break.

As you are all aware, physical distancing rules still apply to all adults at our school. Physical distancing means the requirement for people to distance themselves from others. The more space between you and another adult, the harder it is for the virus to spread. All adults within our schools must maintain a physical distance from each other. It includes physical distancing between teaching staff and other support staff within the school. It also includes physical distancing between staff and other visitors to the school site, such as parents and essential service providers. Only essential adults will be allowed onsite at school. At this stage therapy at school remains on hold. We must maintain this in order to keep staff safe and well to minimise disruption to our students learning. Please call the school any time for clarification or to request to visit the school for essential meetings.

For parents who drive their child to school we ask you to continue to join our car queue and remain in your vehicle at both drop off time and pick up time as you did last term. Our staff will collect your child from your car, eliminating possible adult to adult contact. Your cooperation is very much appreciated.

Please follow the health advice and keep your child home if they are sick, it's important to keep all staff and students on site well. If your child attends school and is showing signs of being unwell you will be asked to pick them up and keep them home until they are well.

Your flexibility, commitment and support for our school community is highly valued and greatly appreciated.
